Looking after your child is our number one priority and it is important that communication with parents is crucial. Unless it is severe you do not need to come to school. If there are any changes to the child's health following the bump, we will keep you updated.

- Round opens 9 September 2022
- Round closes 31 October 2022
- National Offer day school place decisions are made available - 1 March 2023
- Appeals closing date 22 March 2023
- Mini admission round to consider changes 3 April 2023
- Late appeals closing date 19 April 2023
- Appeals hearings May/June 2023
- Waiting lists maintained for over-subscribed schools until 31 December 2023
