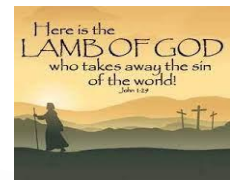

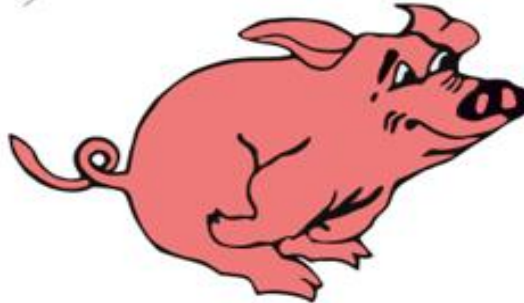
Event will be held in the Studio Hall and corridors.
