### Ella's Fundraising



Our type 1 Diabetic Warrior, Ella, has always wanted to raise awareness for children and young people with type 1 diabetes since she was diagnosed in June 2021, aged just 6 years old.

Ella has decided that she wants to fundraise for a diabetic charity close to her heart but also to support another charity at the same time.

These charities are East of England Compass – Navigating Diabetes, and The Little Princess Trust.

The EECND is the only charity of this kind in the country that provide support and activities to children, young people and their families who live with diabetes, outside of the clinical environment.

In 2003 they set up their diabetes camps and have now seen over 900 children and young people benefit from the opportunities and support from peers, and adults who truly understand what it is like living with the highs and lows of diabetes. The young people are also supported to become more independent to treat their own diabetes in a safe and supported environment.

Past feedback from families tell the charity how much they value these opportunities for their young people and that long friendships have been made. Ella herself has greatly benefitted from these camps.

With your help the EECND will be able to continue to offer more subsidised, or free places for these young people who otherwise would not be able to have these great opportunities.

The other charity that Ella wants to support is The Little Princess Trust who make and supply real hair wigs for young people who have lost their hair through cancer or other conditions.

With all this in mind, Ella has been growing her beautiful hair for the past two years and on world Diabetes Day -14th November 2025 will be having all 17 inches of her hair cut off and will be sending it to The Little Princess Trust.

As a hairdresser, her Mum will be cutting Ella's hair herself in school with her peers.

- Applications close - 31 October 2025
- National offer day (when you get your school offer) - 2 March 2026
- Appeals closing date - 27 March 2026
- Mini admission round starts (when we consider changes parents have made to their applications since the closing date) - 1 April 2026
- Appeals hearings take place - May/June 2026

For all those parents who have children ready to join Reception next academic year, we will be holding our information evenings on 22<sup>nd</sup> October and 10<sup>th</sup> November at 5:30pm. There is no need to book just turn up. Please spread the word to anyone you might know who has a child Reception ready for September 2026.




**Q. Will Premier be taking payments via childcare vouchers?**


